**AMENDING THE LOUDON MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING
SUBSECTION (3) TO TITLE 8, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 207
PERTAINING TO BEER SOLD FOR CONSUMPTION ON A
GOLF COURSE**

Mayor Swiney called the public hearing to order at 7:08 P.M. He called for comments or questions regarding the ordinance.

Mr. Mark Fronczek representing Tennessee National explained that they wanted to extend the courtesy of selling beer for consumption on their golf course. He added that by purchasing on premises rather than bringing their own, they would have better control.

Councilman Garner asked if they would operate a beverage cart. Mr. Fronczek replied that they currently had no plans to operate a cart, but would supply a cooler on the cart. The players would purchase beverages in the clubhouse to take with them.
