

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

LOUDON CITY COUNCIL

August 10, 2009

A Special Called Meeting was held on August 10, 2009 in the Council Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order at 6:37 P.M. Those present were Vice-Mayor Eugene Lambert, Councilmen Lewis Garner, Lynn Millsaps and Mike Cartwright. Mayor Bernie R. Swiney was absent.
